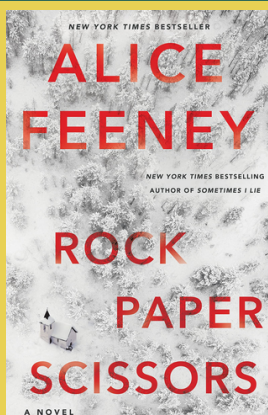

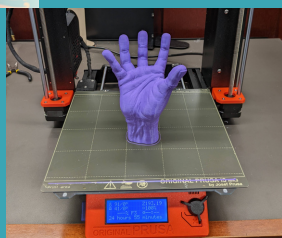

## YA events every other Tuesday

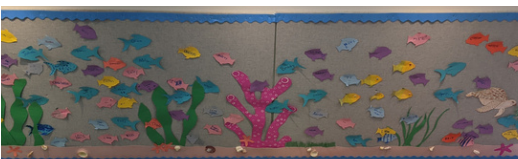
Join us at any of these programs. No registration necessary. Unless otherwise noted, all events run on Tuesdays from 2-4PM in the Community Room on the first floor of the library.
