## New Museum Passes

Are you looking for some fun? Douglas Library has a large selection of museum, leisure and educational activity passes. These passes can be checked out for a discount or free entry to cultural institutions around the state. Most passes can be printed from home, with no due dates and nothing to return to the library.

In the past few months, the library has added Little Theatre of Manchester, New Britain Youth Museum and Hungerford Nature Center, Mashantucket Pequot Museum, Connecticut Trolley Museum, and Springfield Museums to our collection.



**Little Theatre of Manchester** - Buy one get one free for tickets to performances at the theater.

**New Britain Youth Museum/Hungerford Nature Center** - Free admission for up to four people.

**Mashantucket Pequot Museum** - 50 percent off four regular admission tickets.

**Connecticut Trolley Museum** - Two adults and two children free regular admission.

**Springfield Museums** - Buy one get one half off on up to six entries.

### Take and Make

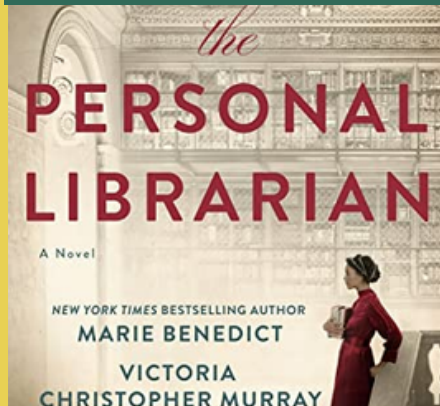
