

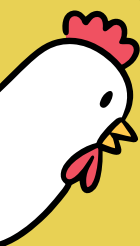

Rent-the-Chicken

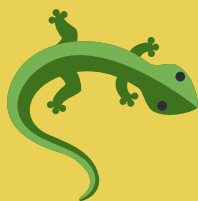
July 13th, 1:00PM

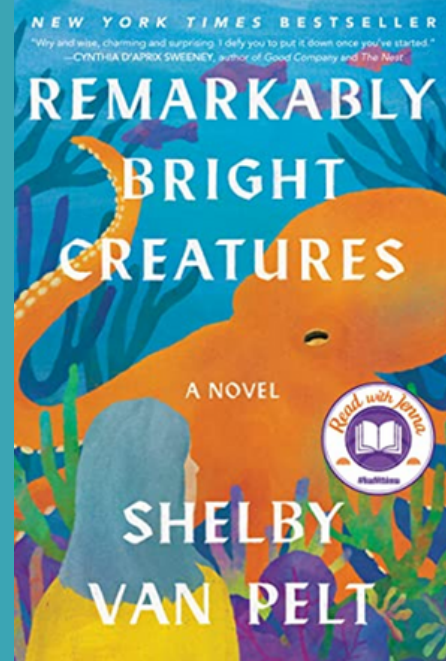
