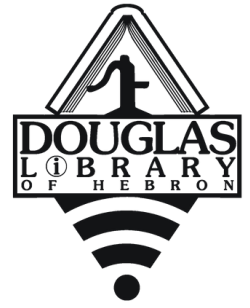

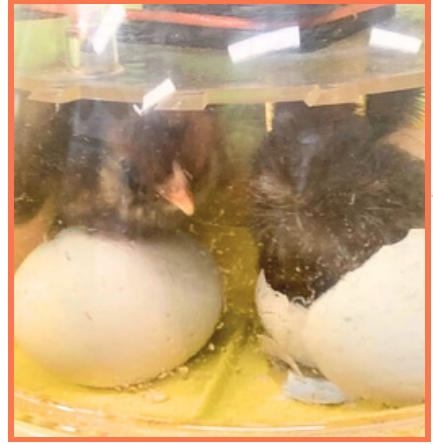
Kids/Teen Events
