## HAUNTED LIBRARY PLANNING MEETINGS

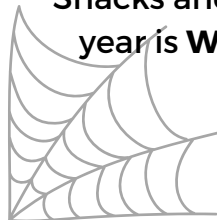
**Wed. Sept 6th , 2:30-3:30PM**

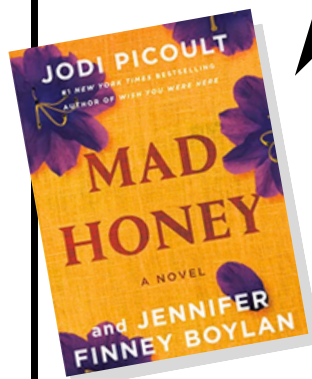

**Sept 13th at noon or 6pm**

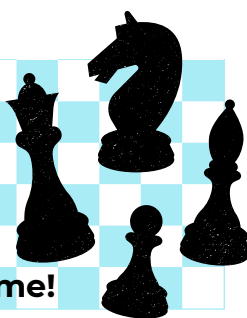

Our Summer Reading Program will close on September 1st, 2023

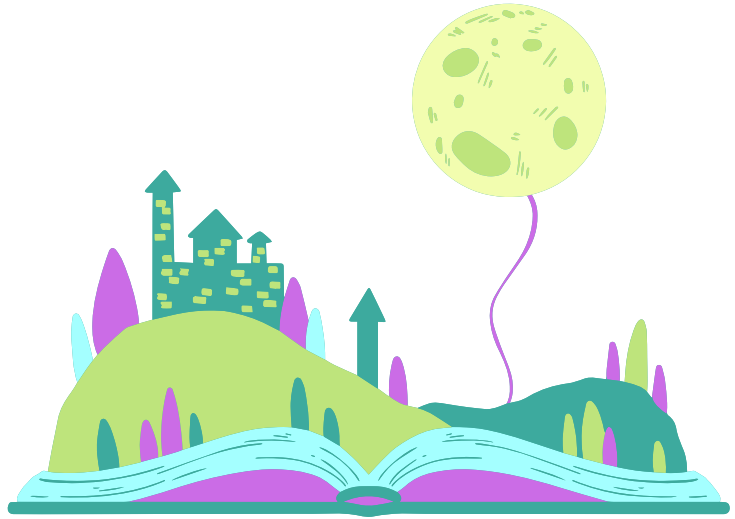
The raffle drawing for the grand prizes will be on September 6th, 2023. Winners will be notified by phone or email and may come in to pick up their prizes during business hours.

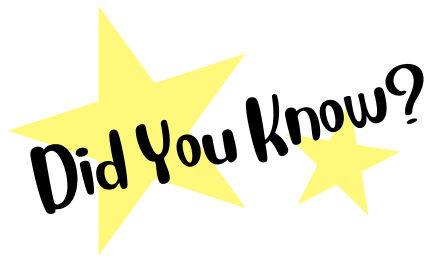
