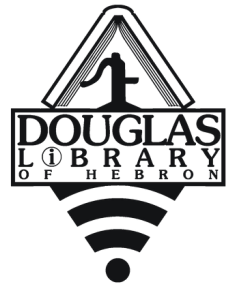

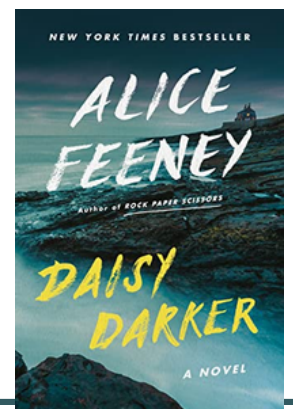
The Spirited Book Club

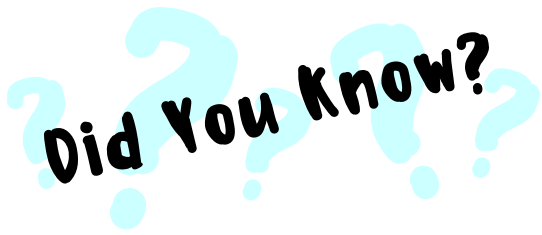
