*Harriet Goodman Grayson*

Connecticut author Harriet Goodman Grayson will share excerpts from and the facts behind her new novel "The Horseman from Baltimore," which tells the story of her father, who served in the China Burma India Theater (CBI) during WW II. A member of the Army Air Corps, it was his love of horses that earned

him a reputation and the moniker the Horseman from Baltimore. In this forgotten military theater, American, British and Indian soldiers and airmen used mules to transport needed supplies from India, across Burma to the Chinese Army fighting the Japanese. Grayson recalls her father's story and brings back the sacrifices made by men and equines in the CBI.

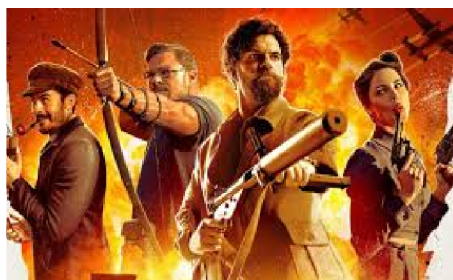

## Cookbook Club

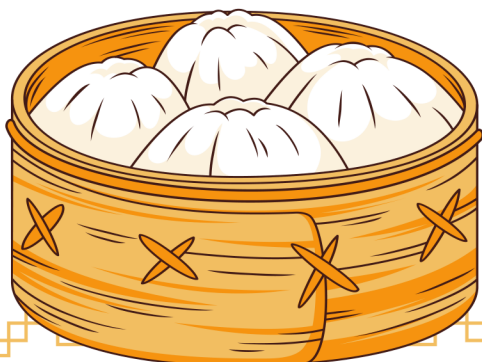
Love to cook? Like to read?
