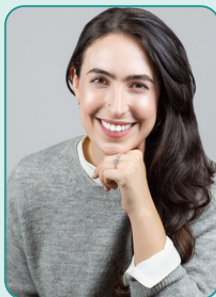

This is geared for ages 3-5. There will be stories, letters, numbers, songs and crafts!

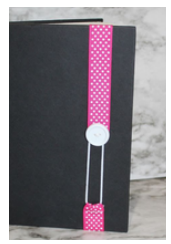
