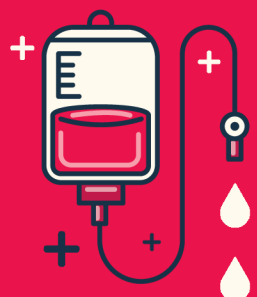

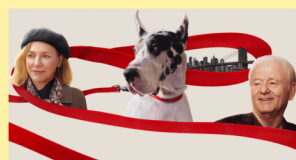

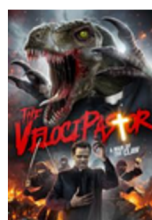
## BAD! Movie Matinees

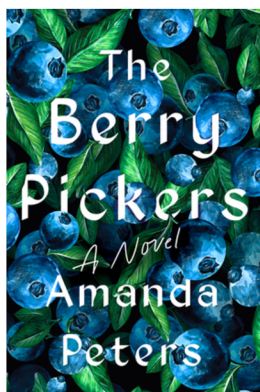

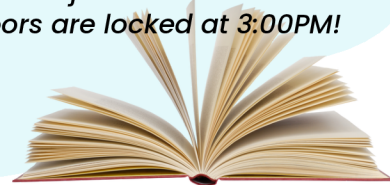


## Quiet Reading Club

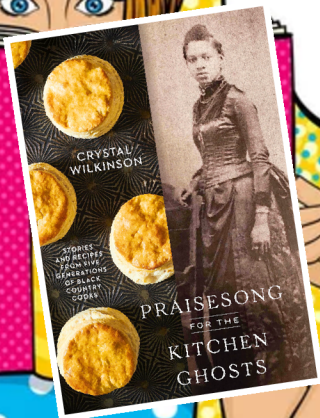
