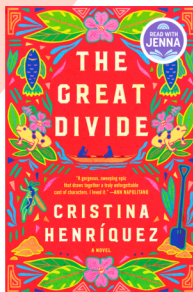
The Spirited Book Club

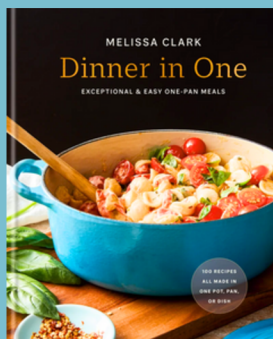
